Saturday 5th Oct – **Harvest Event at the Museum, 2pm – 6pm** with music, crafts, donkey rides, food & drink (full details on facebook).

Sunday 6th October – **Harvest Festival service at St Mary's at 11am** with traditional harvest hymns, and readings & prayers from the children, everyone very welcome; followed by

Village Harvest BBQ lunch in the museum field from 12 noon £8 per person (cash or card), free for under 13s, for a burger and hotdog. There will be a bar (and a couple of marquees in case of rain).
